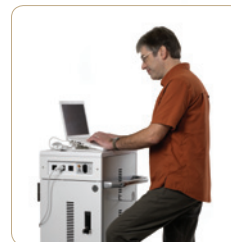

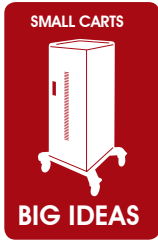

## Why You'll Love Anthro's Tablet Charging Cart

### 1 Size

The cart was designed with a very compact footprint (2'x2', about the size of a water cooler) because we knew it had to be at home in crowded classrooms. With class sizes increasing, space will only get tighter. At that size, it fits between rows of desks, it's easy to maneuver, and it tucks into any corner when not in use.



### 2 Separate Locking IT Area

Protect and conceal power adapters and outlets behind their own locking door. IT staff installs the tablets into the cart, organizes and plugs in the cords just the way they want them, then locks it all away so users don't have access.



### 3 Multi-purpose Design

At 46" high, it's a comfortable teaching station. Space is tight in classrooms, so everything has to do double-duty. Pull the laptop and projector up onto the top surface, plug them into the outlets on the side, and you have a compact, mobile teaching station.



- 4 So easy to move. The 18"-wide handle gives you a good grip. Large 4" casters (all locking) move smoothly over any surface.
- 5 The doors' **two-point locking system** keeps your tablets secure.
- 6 Use the **keyed locks on the front and back** or add your own padlock!
- 7 There's a **laptop storage slot** up front where you need it. The deep slot measures 12.75"w x 15.5"d x 1.75"h.
- 8 **Roomy storage bays** (7/8"w x 8-1/2"h x 10-1/2"d) hold common devices, with or without a protective case. The bay dividers are metal, so they'll last and last.
- 9 The **cable management system** positions power connectors at the front of the bay for easy connection. Then cords route along the top of the bay divider into the IT area where they're bundled and adapters plug in.
- 10 Ventilated **doors open 270°** so they're flush against the side of the cart when open. Side panels and inner divider are also ventilated so tablets stay cool.
- 11 The control panel contains **3 external outlets** for powering laptops and peripherals and an on/off switch that directs power to the cart – the glowing indicator light lets you know when power is on.





- One top teaching surface with 1/4" lip
- Two ventilated side panels
- One cable wrap with 14' power cord
- Three external power receptacles
- One on/off switch with power indicator light
- One 18" wide handle
- Two ventilated reinforced 18-gauge metal doors with keyed handle, padlock hasps and 2-point locking system
- Front user area with four rows of 10 storage bays made of 16-gauge metal
- 18-gauge divider panel between front user area and back IT area with slim openings to route cables
- Back IT area with 42 power receptacles
- Welded metal base with four 3" footrests and four 4" locking casters.
