






Read through instruction sheet and check to make sure you have all parts before beginning assembly and installation. You will need assistance to complete the final step in assembling the Table Top Stand.

TOOLS REQUIRED: Phillips head screwdriver and open end wrench.







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
OPTIONAL: For 360° swivel, attach race as shown in step three. For no swivel, skip step three and attach adhesive feet (\mathbf{R}) at four corners and front edge of base. Set feet back off edges about 3 inches.


3-2 Flip race over and align one of

four middle holes from top of


Attach race (N) to bottom of base (A). Lay base on flat surface as shown in step 3-3.

 3-1 Locate four middle holes on top of race (N) circled in Top View.






3-3 Align one large hole and middle hole with one pilot hole in base (A) and place race (N) on base.




DETAIL 1

3-4 Thread one screw (O) into pilot hole in base (A) leaving screw slightly loose.

3-5 Rotate bottom of race (N) 180° and align large hole and middle hole with pilot hole. Fasten with one screw (O) leaving slightly loose. Rotate race and fasten two screws (O) at 90° intervals into remaining pilot holes, then tighten all four screws. Finally remove sticky back from adhesive felt race (L) and adhere to race (N).






Note: Refer to accompanying instruction sheet to attach adapter bracket to screen.

Attach tilt plate (D) to adapter bracket (attached to screen) using four screws (T). Attach tilt bracket (E) to tilt plate (D) using two screws (J).

Notes:

- Choose holes on tilt plate according to size of screen.
- There is a 9" maximum distance between bottom of screen and tilt plate (**D**) shown in Side & Back View. Exceeding maximum distance may interfere with tilt.



AWARNING

• Do not lift more weight than you can handle. Use additional man power to safely handle placement of the screen.

Attach screen/tilt plate (D) to support box (B).





5-1 Note: Two people are required for this step, one holding each end of screen.

> Tilt screen back, then carefully slide tilt plate (D) into slots and lift up into support box. Level screen engaging notch in tilt plate (D) with steel rod inside support box (B).

Tilt plate is secure on steel rod of support box (B) when hole is visible on indicator as shown in detail 3. To ensure screen is properly placed, screen can be tilted 5° back and 10° forward. Thread knob (Q) with washer (M) into tilt bracket (E) through slot in rear of support box (B).



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
